The low down on load shedding

LOAD shedding is an unfortunate fact of life for Durban residents as the municipality does its bit to ease the national electricity supply shortage.

Councillors and officials are aware of how inconvenient the outages can be and every effort is being made to keep disruptions to a minimum.

The municipality has received many questions about load shedding. In an effort to keep residents informed, here are some answers to common queries.

Why am I affected when other areas are not?

Areas not affected may be on the same transformer or circuit which supplies a major hospital, water works, critical load that would have a serious regional impact if isolated. Centres with predominantly high-rise buildings are also avoided.

Also, some circuits cannot be opened and closed without sending staff to do this manually.

Why not do load shedding at night?

Load shedding has to take place immediately when the load is predicted to exceed generation capacity and this normally happens during the day when businesses are using electricity and in the early morning and evening when most households are using electricity.

Late at night and on weekends when there is low load, there is less likelihood of the load exceeding

hence less likelihood of load shedding being required.

Will the municipality compensate me for losses?

The municipality is simply responding to the national situation and cannot be held liable for interruptions. No electricity utility in the world can guarantee supply at all times. Customers must provide for the possibility of an interruption at any time.

Why does the schedule provide for two-and-a-halfhours for each block?

The principle of two-hour blocks still applies but some overlap has to be expected to provide for the many switching steps involved. At the end of the two hours the circuits of the next block have to be isolated before

the circuits of the previous block can be restored or this would defeat the purpose of load shedding.

Will I always be in the same block?

Smaller distribution substations are supplied by major substations via multiple circuits and it is possible the source of supply could be changed for reasons apart from load shedding. It

is possible this would result in the customer being associated with a different

Will there be more changes to the schedule?

As customers become familiar with the blocks that affect them, further changes will be avoided. eThekwini values constructive comments and suggestions and will certainly take these

into account if practical.

It must also be recognised that Eskom might require a greater load reduction than each defined block can provide. If this were to happen regularly, blocks of load including commercial and light industrial customers would have to be developed for a Stage-2 load shedding schedule.

Load shedding programmes for eThekwini

THE eThekwini Electricity Department has drawn up a programme to switch off "blocks" of the metro's mainly residential loads.

Load shedding is done by the department at short notice on request by Eskom, depending on the supply and demand for power.

The department's load shedding programmes are intended to minimise inconvenience to customers. For this reason power will not be cut to the same areas at the same times on consecutive days instead two programmes will apply.
