



Notice of amendment to the contract for electronic enforcement technology and the provision of operational and back office support for the processing of violations

In terms of the Municipal Finance and Management Act Section 116(3) (a) and (b) notice is hereby given of the proposed amendment of the following contract: Supply, installation, maintenance in respect of electronic enforcement technology (red light, speed, ANPR) and the provision of operational and back office support for the processing of violations.

The scope of work has remained unchanged, however, the contract period has to be extended on a month to month basis, or a period of six months , until the new tender process is finalised, whichever , is the sooner.

The main reasons for the delay in finalising the new tender is that the department is exploring alternate solutions to the existing contract. In addition, and most critical is the impact of the possible implementation of the Administrative, Adjudication of Road Traffic Offences Act (AARTO), which would have changed certain requirements and if process proceeded without consideration thereto would have resulted in wasted expenditure.

The contract rates for the extension will be in line with prior year's escalation rates.
