The eThekwini Municipality's 2010 Greening Workstream has identified the need for upgrading of visitor facilities at Burman Bush Nature Reserve to improve the range and quality of eco-tourism experiences on offer during the 2010 World Cup Soccer event to be hosted in Durban. In line with the accepted 2010 investment approach of creating a positive legacy for Durban, this project will not only serve visitors of the 2010 World Cup, but also residents and visitors to the eThekwini Municipality in the long term. Furthermore, it offers the opportunity to empower local communities, create employment and

address the declining safety and serviceability status of Burman Bush Nature Reserve as a Municipal Asset. **The project involves the establishment of:** An approx. 640m long elevated tree canopy boardwalk through Burman Bush Nature Reserve with a single viewing tower, An Environmental Education and Trails Centre; Curio Shop; Improved parking and access.
