RATIONALISATION OF ETHEKWINI MUNICIPALITY'S BYLAWS

Tenders are hereby invited from suitable professional consultants to provide a Rationalisation of eThekwini Municipality's Bylaws. **The broad scope of the work required:**

1. Conduct a study of all the current bylaws of eThekwini, including those local councils that were incorporated into eThekwini after the year 2000;

2. Conduct an audit of eThekwini bylaws in order to-
 - a) identify gaps in the existing bylaws; and
 - b) identify bylaws which conflict with constitutional provisions;
3. Weed out all obsolete bylaws;
4. Draft amendments to the existing bylaws or new bylaws, in order to fill in gaps and bring eThekwini's bylaws up-to-date;
5. Co-ordinate the public comments phase required by section 160(4) of the constitution;
6. Generally ensure that

eThekwini's bylaws comply with the RSA Constitution, National and Provincial Legislation and incorporate relevant best practice principles, and

7. Transfer the knowledge to the LSU at the end of the contract.
