Contract responses

- 1. May I ask if the relevant experience is only strictly on supply and delivery or it may be any tendering experience?**

Relevant experience is only strictly on supply and delivery of chemicals specified on the document, which consist of brown hydrated lime, sodium carbonate -Anhydrous (soda ash dense) and liquid sodium hypochlorite, HTH stabilizing tablet. A reference letter is required as proof of experience.

- 2. The Quality Management Service means what exactly? In terms of documentation needed for this tender.**

With regards to the quality management system, the tender needs to supply a certificate of analysis for the chemicals. If the tenderer is not the manufacturer, then tender must supply a copy of the manufacturers is ISO certificate. MSDS will not be considered as part of the QMS evaluation.

- 3. In addition to my previous email below I'd also like to know must we bidders price for all chemicals required?**

Tenderers have the option of bidding for individual chemical as specified on the document. Tenderers are not obligated to bid for all the specified chemicals.

- 4. •Section 8 (Schedule of rates table) – After the pricing schedules of all requested chemicals what information must be recorded on the “schedule of rates” table?**

Pricing must include transportation cost. The treatment works and the quantities are specified on the document. Tenderer pricing must be based on the information specified.

- 5. •Performance Security (SCC 7.1 & 7.4) – What information is required for this sub-section? Because we as Deefour source the requested chemicals from either suppliers or manufacturers. Insurance (SCC 11.1) – What supporting documents is required for this sub-section?**

The performance security and Insurance clauses are part of the conditions of contract found in page 48 of the tender document. This will be discussed with the tenderer that is awarded the contract before commencement of the contract.
